Description	

8 artists from 4 project partner cities (Daugavpils, Latvia; Ignalina, Lithuania; Serock, Poland and Prachatice, Czechia), which included 1 male and 1 female artist from each partner, came together in Daugavpils, Latvia, for a one-week long residency to create original artworks in the painting medium for a public exhibition at the Rothko Museum, Daugavpils, Latvia, reflecting through creative means on the core European value of equality in general and between genders in particular.

During the week, the 8 artists-in-residency painted their work and drew inspiration from mutual exchanges in the studios, visits to local cultural landmarks and meetings with local male and female artists.

Also during the residency week, the 8 artists-in-residency presented their creative portfolios and perspectives on gender equality in everyday life and in the art world in particular in a public presentation and Q&A session at the Rothko Museum, which was attended by museum staff, local artists and art students as well as regular citizens with an interest in the project theme.

Finally, the 8 artists-in-residency opened an exhibition at the Rothko Museum, Daugavpils, Latvia, displaying the artworks they had created during the residency. The vernissage was attended by museum staff, local artists and art students, municipality officials and citizens with an interest in the project theme.

The exhibition which resulted from the residency remains on show at the Rothko Museum till the end of summer 2024.
